



For job seekers in Montana, apprenticeship is a pathway to above-average employment outcomes.


Apprenticeship programs graduate around **300** highly skilled workers every year!

In the past **4** years, **27** new occupations have become apprenticeable in Montana!


High Demand Apprenticeable Occupations
